

ICT in PDHPE Webinars: Professional Learning Network/Google docs

Dear PDHPE coordinator,

ACHPER NSW is offering PDHPE teachers an opportunity to participate in two online 1 ½ hour ICT webinars. A Webinar, or "Web seminar," is an online event designed to facilitate communication between a presenter and a large remote audience using the Internet. The audience can ask questions and get responses during the webinar. Teachers can access the webinar individually through a computer or a number of staff through a data projector.

Thursday 25th March Participants will be able to utilise the web to develop a **professional learning network** to access and share quality resources and ideas. Participants will learn how to set up different applications and how they can be used to save both time and effort in accessing quality resources.

Thursday 29th April This session looks at how **Google docs** can be used in the classroom as an assessment learning tool. Learn how to develop simple surveys and quizzes for students and create programming or examination documents that can be shared.

(It is recommended that participants have access to TWO screens/computers - one to view the presentation and one so that you can work through different activities during the session)
